2) CARBON OFFSETTING THROUGH SURFARIS FOREST

We collaborate with Reforesta NGO through the Surfaris forest initiative to offset emissions and help restore local ecosystems. We invite every traveler to learn about and support this project.

3) EFFICIENT WATER USE

We kindly request that you moderate water consumption during the trip and in our facilities, prioritizing short showers and mindful use in sensitive areas.

4) REDUCTION OF PLASTIC USE

We encourage the use of reusable bottles and utensils. Bring yours. Our facilities provide filtered water stations for continuous refills.

5) RESPONSIBLE WASTE MANAGEMENT

We practice recycling in our facilities. Inside the lodge, you will find designated containers for separating waste, and we encourage maintaining this practice during the tour and throughout local visits.

6) RESPECT FOR FLORA AND FAUNA

Please keep a proper distance, avoid feeding wildlife, and follow responsible behavior guidelines in natural areas.

7) SUPPORT FOR THE LOCAL ECONOMY

We recommend purchasing products from local entrepreneurs to support the community and promote sustainable development in the region.

8) CARE FOR NATURAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

Respect cultural sites, trails, signs, and viewpoints. Avoid removing natural elements or intervening in protected areas.

9) MEANINGFUL ACTIVITIES

During every surf session, we engage in beach clean ups and guided visits. Travelers are invited to actively participate in these environmental and community focused actions.

10) RESPONSIBLE AND LOCAL FOOD

We prioritize menus featuring local, fresh, and seasonal products, supporting regional production and local restaurants

11) SAFETY AND RESPECT FOR LOCAL REGULATIONS

Follow the guide's instructions, respect restricted areas, and maintain safe behavior to protect both people and the ecosystem.

12) ANIMAL WELFARE

We do not participate in activities involving direct handling or causing stress to wildlife. Only responsible observation is allowed.

13) SUSTAINABLE ACCOMMODATION

Our lodge operates with efficient practices in energy, water, and waste, and aligns with sustainable tourism principles in the Ñuble region.

14) RESPONSIBLE ENERGY USE

Please turn off lights, electrical devices, and minimize heating use when not needed, following an energy efficient approach.

15) PARTICIPATION, FEEDBACK, AND COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION
